#### SHUTTLEBUS TO SALZBURG



A minibus will take you to the center of Salzburg. It is a one-hour-drive. Enjoy the day in one of the most fascinating and beautiful cities of the world. ### GUIDED TOUR IN THE VILLAGE OF ST. WOLFGANG



Famous local guides will take you around the village. St. Wolfgang is very famous for its very impressive gothic altar in the pilgrimage church of Saint Wolfgang. #### TRIP TO UNTERACH ON THE ATTERSEE



In one of his most famous paintings "Houses in Unterach on the Attersee" (around 1916) Gustav KLIMT captured the beauty of Unterach. At the beginning of the 20th century a number of famous artists, writers, and scientists like Johannes Brahms, Maria Jeritza and Viktor Kaplan used to meet here.

During World War II Unterach served as a place of refuge for a pioneer of the pharmaceutical industry, Emil Bertalanffy, graduate in civil engineering, who founded one of the leading Austrian pharmaceutical companies – EBEWE Pharma.



A guided tour through the facilities will give you an interesting insight into the high-tech manufacturing of specialty pharmaceuticals (oncology drugs) that are being used to treat cancer all over the world
